Thank you for participating in the 7th annual Barbera Festival! Projected attendance is around 2,000, which includes all attendees, winery personnel, volunteers, media, and special guests.

Application and Fee due **August 1st**

To participate, the following forms must be received no later than August 1st.

New for 2017: An open area will be available for up to 10 individual pop-ups, provided by the vendor. Participation is limited to 3 vendor tents and 10 individual pop-up tents, for a total of 34 spaces. Pop-up area is reserved and limited to white pop-ups only!

Fee is \$100, payable to the Amador Community Foundation (see Application for payment details). Vendors retain 100% of sales and are responsible for all taxes and fees.

Each Vendor Receives: Each vendor in the tent area is provided with a 10' x 10' space under a 20' x 40' structured tent, 6' table, 2 chairs (unless otherwise noted that these are not needed), admittance for you and one helper (if requested), and free parking. Please bring a covering for your table. Table and chairs are NOT provided in the pop-up area. You must bring your own.

There is no Wireless Reception at the Winery so please consider this in regards to using Square or other Wireless Payment systems.

- **FOOD PRODUCTS:** Amador County requires all vendors selling an edible product to:
 - Submit a Temporary Food Facility form (<http://www.co.amador.ca.us/home/showdocument?id=4265>).
 - Check "**Other**" and write in "*Annual Temp Event Permit*"
 - The TFF will be dated Jan 2017 - Dec 2017 and is valid for *all events* for that year
 - A fee of \$32 per event or \$96 for all events within a calendar year is required, payable to *County of Amador*
 - Send the form and payment to AMADOR COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT, 810 Court Street, Jackson, California 95642

Arrival and Unloading

Gates open at 7:30 am. Please plan to arrive **before 9:30am.** Please follow the signs to your unloading and parking area. (See map at the end of this document.)

No vehicles will be allowed in after 10:00am. Please be kind to your neighbors and move your vehicle as quickly as possible. Volunteers will be onsite to help you unload, if needed.

All vehicles must be moved by 10:00am.

Finding Your Location – Checking In: Each vendor is preassigned a location in one of the 3 Vendor Tents or Pop-up area. Please check in at the *Winery/Vendor Check-in Tent* to receive your wristband and glass. All persons within the event must have a wristband – *no exceptions.*

At the end of the day: For the safety of our attendees, **no vehicles are allowed in the event area until 4:15pm.**

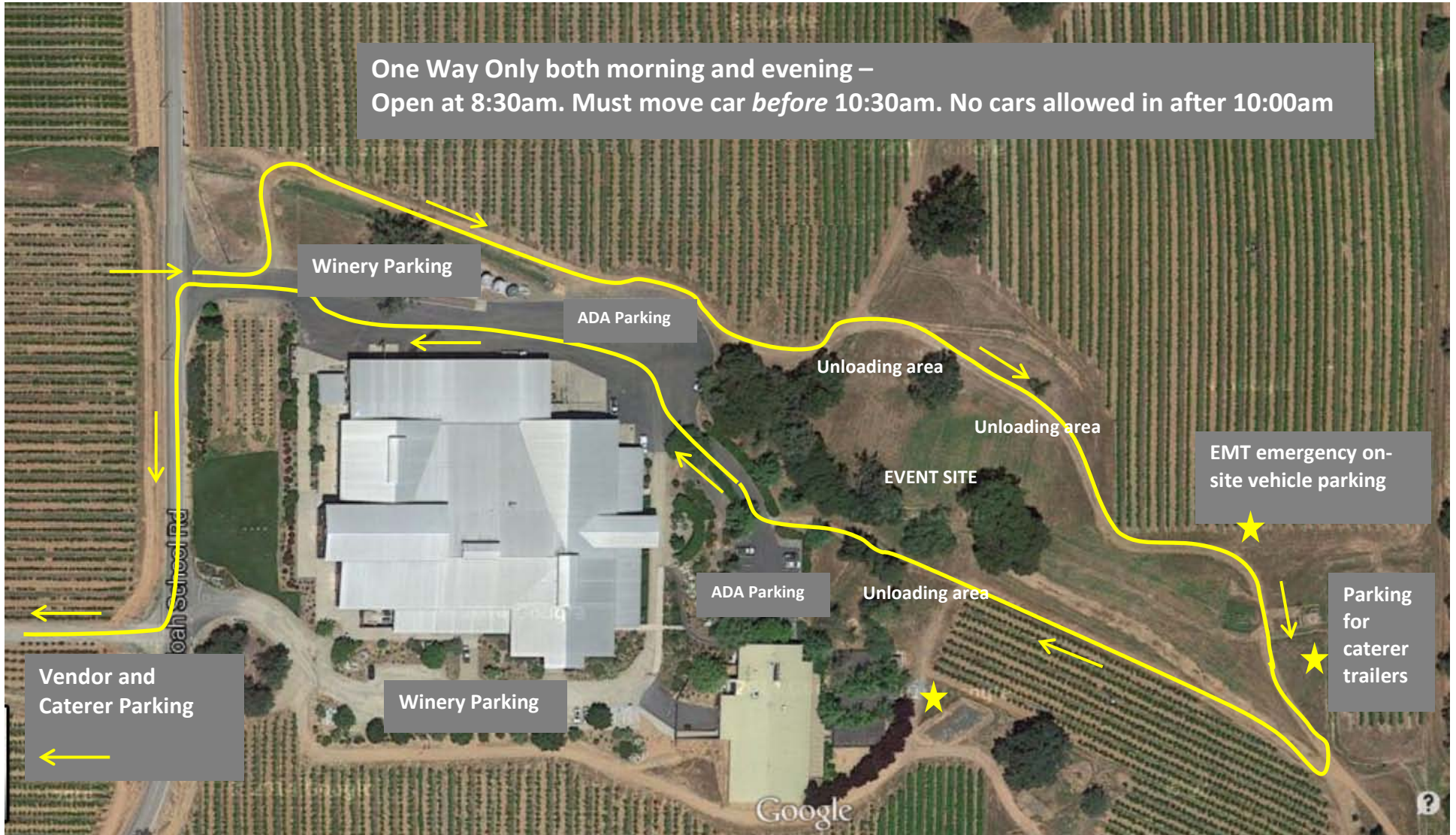
